It takes an intrepid spirit to conjure up a fresh take on a cultural icon. Synonymous with cafe culture of years gone by, the bistro chair is a cultural mainstay, yet its iconic status did little to deter Ross Didier.

Enter ETIQUETTE - a bistro chair with similar character form of all the bistro chairs you've ever met - but with a twist. It's a humble, structural departure that offers a fresh new look for an established icon whilst delivering distinctive seating for contemporary hospitality interiors.

ETIQUETTE radiates comfort and intimacy — a compelling triage conducive to forming connections with others when sharing a table. Like modern etiquette, the experience of is one of respect and humility, designed for those who appreciate subtle charm.

In its simplicity and beautifully proportioned volumes, Etiquette conjures up an instant sense of the familiar but with a sense of the new. At first, you're not entirely sure why this design makes so much impact.

On closer reflection, you notice the beautifully shaped seats carved from solid timber, and the elongated twisting taper of the chairs back legs and that the steel-legged table pedestals gently splay and taper to the floor, bringing the language of the two pieces into unison.

ETIQUETTE is a close family made in solid ash, and composed of the chair, bar stool, dining and bar tables. Tabletops are offered in a range of round and square sizes and optional finishes.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Gently clean any marks with a soft dampened cloth then dry.
- Vacuum upholstery to remove dry dirt and dust. Dust timber with dry cloth or feather duster.
- Avoid areas with heat, direct sunlight and moisture fluctuating temperatures.
- Fabric and leather companies have their own 'care and maintenance' instructions for each product.
- Didier recommends always reading the label of any cleaning products and not using cleaning agents containing abrasives or solvents.
